

District 30 Tournament Participants:

Based on the first several games, please communicate the following to all managers at all age groups:

- Special Pinch Runner: Once per inning, twice per game....AND the same player cannot be removed for a Special Pinch Runner more than once in a game.
- There are NO scorekeepers or pitch count keepers outside of the dugout. IF you keep a scorebook, it must be done inside the dugout by one of the coaches listed on the affidavit. Having a coach/parent sitting outside or being used for consultative purposes of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- If you have 11 or fewer players at a game, only two coaches are allowed in the dugout. There are NO exceptions.
- Under any and all circumstances, you may NEVER have more than three coaches participating in any pre-game warm-ups. ONLY the three coaches on the affidavit are allowed to be anywhere "inside". LL insurance forbids more than those 3 coaches from participation. Some teams have more coaches than a football coaching staff than a LL coaching staff.
- Coaches are NEVER allowed to warm-up a pitcher. It must be a properly equipped player.
- There are no automatic pinch runners for catchers. The 7:14 rule and/or a valid substitution that is tied to the catcher are the only ways to pinch run for the catcher.
- At the District level, we are prepping teams for expectations and rules for Sections, States, Regionals and LLWS, please recognize that and follow the rules. Don't take advantage of a District Rep's good nature by trying to usurp the rules.
